The art of making the premium paint brush is at the heart of the paintbrushes are handcrafted by skilled craftsmen who have been making paintbrushes for years. Attamark brushes are made of natural blend of both.

Natural bristle is not recommended for latex or acrylic paints causing it to flare or become too soft to paint effectively.

Also, rough surfaces will break the tips off natural bristle so it is not a good brush for painting rough surfaces - even when using oilbased paint.



Paint Brush Tips

USING A NEW BRUSH

When first using a new brush, start by slowly stirring it in the paint to slightly spread the bristles, allowing them to hold paint better. Then dip the brush straight up and down two or three times until the bristles are saturated about a third of their length.

CLEANING & MAINTAINING

After the paint job is done, start the cleaning process by gently scraping excess paint from a paintbrush onto paper, working from the ferrule to the tips.

If the paintbrush has latex or waterbased paint on it, then rinse as much paint out as you can with warm water flowing over the outside of the bristles, toward the bristle ends. Next dip the paintbrush into a container of soapy water and rapidly move it back and forth. Refill the container halfway with just clear warm water and repeat the process. Continue the fresh-water rinsing process until the water remains perfectly clear.

For a paintbrush that has solventbased paint on it, scrape away excess paint from the paintbrush and then using a clean paint can, pour about 1 inch of thinner into the can. Rinse out the paintbrush in the thinner, repeat the process several times to get the paintbrush clean.
